



# Highlights of Changes in 2.0.15.142

### Access Right Panel to differentiate between User ID and User Group

AutoCount Accounting had brought back a small feature which is available in previous version whereby user able to differentiate between User ID and User Group through the icons from the access right side panel under Access Right Maintenance (Refer Figure 1).



User can realise that for **User ID**, the icon is a single person head while for **User Group**, it is a two person head icon.





## Main Supplier and Main Supplier Desc for Multi-Dimensional Report

2 new fields had been added into Multi-Dimensional Report – **Main Supplier and Main Supplier Desc** (Refer Figure 2). This 2 fields are **originate from Stock Item Maintenance** (Refer Figure 3) where user use to set the main supplier of particular item and to be used in Purchase Request. User can now run the report with these information for own analysis purpose.





## **Tile Shortcut for Cash Receipt and Cash Payment**

2 Tiles shortcut had been added to directly access Cash Receipt and Cash Payment for convenient purpose. User can add these shortcut from Home Screen  $\rightarrow$  Top Right Setting Icon  $\rightarrow$  Widget Setting  $\rightarrow$  Select "Function" Type  $\rightarrow$  Click Customize  $\rightarrow$  Category GL  $\rightarrow$  Select Cash Receipt or Cash Payment  $\rightarrow$  Click on the "Select (>>)" button to add in  $\rightarrow$  Click OK when done (Refer Figure 4).



User will realise that there is 2 new shortcuts appear at the homescreen under GL category (Refer Figure 5). These 2 shortcuts allows you to **directly create a new transaction** instead of the Cash Book shortcut which requires you to select Receipt Voucher or Payment Voucher after click.








