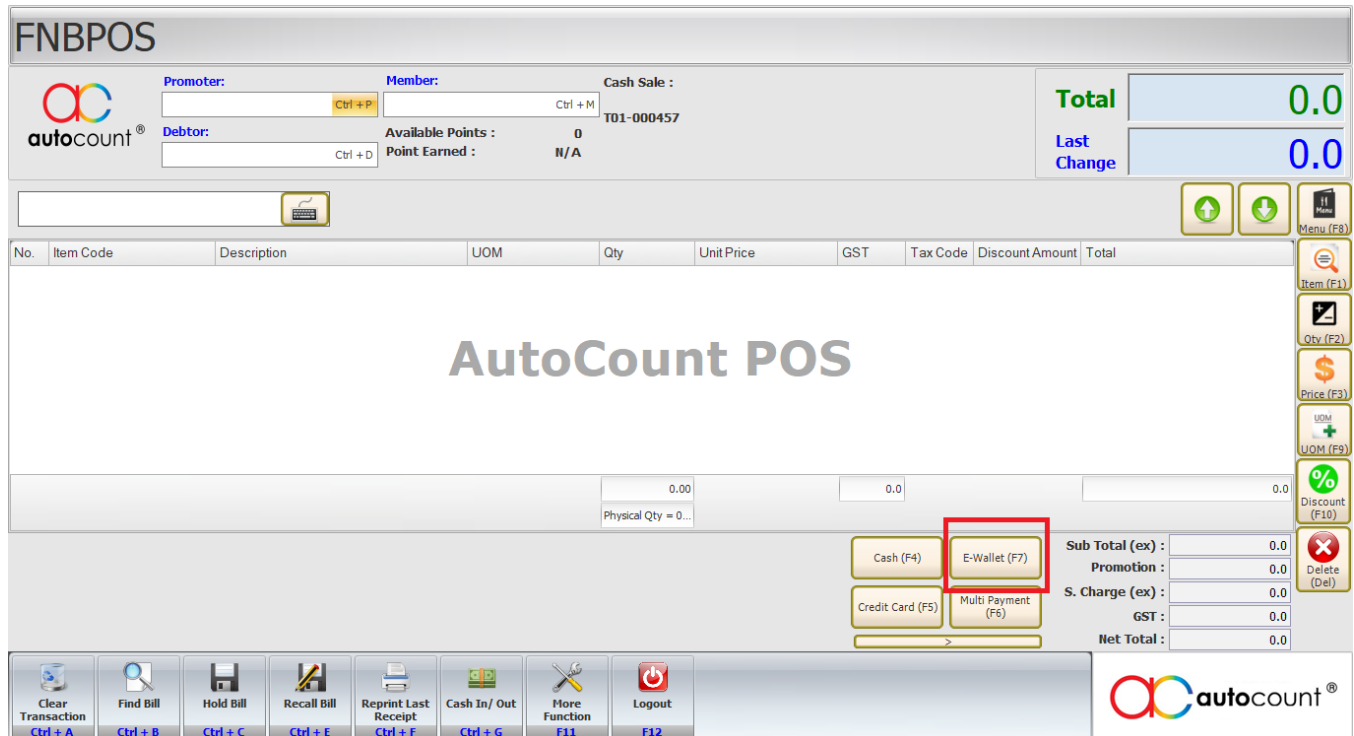

Highlights of Changes in 5.0.35.185

ID: 12982 Add shortcut key for e-wallet payment.

Due to the frequent usage of E-wallet, we have adjusted that previous F7 was for Credit Sales to be replaced by E-wallet and Credit Sales will get assigned a new shortcut key which is Ctrl + F4. If the E-wallet option is disabled, the shortcut key for Credit Sales will remain which is F7.
